It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of BMI Alumni Association Executive Board member and Past President Angelo Candelori '56. Angelo is single-handedly responsible for organizing our Alumni Association. In 1985, he saw an article and photo in a Trenton newspaper describing how seven BMI graduates met occasionally for lunch. Angelo suggested to them that at their next lunch they invite any BMI graduates that they could find. The result was that in September of 1987, ninety-seven graduates attended and thus the Bordentown Military Institute Alumni Association was born. Angelo served on the Executive Board continuously since the beginning and was President for several years. In 2012 the Alumni Association, along with the City of Bordentown, honored him with an Outstanding Citizen Proclamation. At his insistence, it is a closely guarded secret that he was the model for our Cadet Statue.
